The community assembly at Boeing / Hawker De Havilland stays strong! 350 workers at the plant have been on strike since Thursday August 17 in support union delegates. After an internal investigation into 19 workers Boeing has selectively sacked 3 shop stewards in what appears to be blatant victimization of union delegates. Boeing have ran to the AIRC and gained court orders directing a return to work, a mass meeting on August 22 voted to continue the strike.

Background.

Management at Boeing claim to have terminated 3 union members due to "serious misconduct". Boeing claims that the workers were overpaid for study received on-site. Unions and fellow workers don't concede any wrongdoing, the unions in fact sought to have the matter privately arbitrated. Boeing has failed to present any solid evidence. With the loss of a recent contract and an upcoming EBA (Enterprise Bargaining Agreement) it appears that Boeing is looking for a few scalps. Boeing is fond of peaching "Ethics" to their employees. Boeing's behaviour in unfairly sacking shop stewards and trying to force workers back to work through court orders is hardly ethical, so much for fairness!

Wider Support Required

Workers at Boeing have received tremendous support from the community. If they are to win their struggle they require much more. Your support can make a big difference. Don't be shy everyone has something to offer. Hold a meeting at your local pub, with your political group, church or community organization and pass a support motion. Write to your local newspaper about the issue. Organise a fundraiser. Be creative.
