SPOTLIGHT VIGIL

The Eastern Community Action Group will be staging a protest Vigil outside the front entrance of the Spotlight store located at 224 Canterbury Road, Bayswater on Saturday 22 July between 11.00am and midday.

Under new AWAs (individual employment contracts) that are being forced on Spotlight employees across the nation workers will lose substantial penalties and loadings for working weekends, nights, public holidays and overtime. Meal, first aid and other allowances have also been eliminated in the AWAs. The offset for all these losses is a 2c increase in the hourly rate of pay. This will cost staff hundreds of dollars in their weekly pay packets.

All opponents of the harsh new industrial laws that allow these sorts unfair AWAs to be forced on workers should make every effort to come along to this Vigil and join in our protest.
