On 5 July 2006, the Australian Building Construction Commission [ABCC] started legal action in the Federal Court against 107 construction workers on the Perth to Mandurah rail project.

The power-drunk Howard Government is trying to use its unfair new work laws to crush 107 WA CFMEU members and their families.

These proud WA unionists now face fines of \$28,600 each. Even worse, the **WA107** and their families now risk losing their homes because of crippling legal bills that could add up to millions of dollars.

The **WA107** became the target for this unjust legal attack after they stood by their mate, CFMEU Shop Steward Peter Ballard.
